required to demolish the existing concrete cellar box around BM Wellhead 5C. Tasks include removal of existing steel grating, soil and reinforced concrete, and installation of barricades. Excavated soil shall be left in a central area as designated by the SMTR. The excavated limestone and clay layers shall be stockpiled as directed by the SMTR for possible future use. The removed steel grating and reinforced concrete shall be recycled if

possible. Work does not include cleaning the concrete prior to demolition.
