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Section B, Paragraph B.1.d – Paragraph B.1.d is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“d. The minimum offer quantity is **100,000** barrels with a maximum awarded contract quantity of 5,000,000 barrels per offer. An offeror may submit multiple offers, but total awards to Offeror will not exceed 10 million barrels. “

Section M, Paragraph M.2.d - Paragraph M.2.d is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“d. The DOE reserves the right to award a contract for a volume of Exchange Oil that is less than the volume offered as submitted on the Offer Form at Exhibit A, unless the Offeror specifies otherwise in the offer, e.g., all or none. However, in no instance shall DOE award a volume less than **100,000** barrels or volume greater than 5,000,000 barrels unless it is in the interest of the DOE.”
